



David A. Straz, Jr. Center for the Performing Arts
Still Photography Policy

In consideration of permission to photograph presented events at the David A. Straz, Jr. Center for the Performing Arts, it is agreed and understood that:

- On a case-by-case basis, photo access may be granted to a photographer who is on a confirmed assignment from a specific publication, news organization or reputable local website.
 - No access will be granted to photo agencies.
- Photographers will never be given access to Straz Center presented events without approval from the Straz Center PR team. Approval from artist management alone is not sufficient. The Straz Center PR team works closely with artist management to seek approval on requests.
- Photographers must be accompanied by a Straz Center representative at all times while on site with their equipment.
- Photographs may only be taken from an area designated by a Straz Center representative and for a time period which may vary by event.
- Only non-flash photography is permitted.
- Photos taken with approved access must be used in the timely promotion of the show at the Straz Center, of the Straz Center itself, or of a Straz Center partner and may only be used for the approved outlet.
 - Websites must provide the Straz Center PR team with a link to coverage within 48 hours.

Under no circumstance whatsoever can photographs taken at the Straz Center be sold or used for merchandise, posters, calendars, programs, books, publishing, commercial tie-ins, the direct or indirect endorsement of any products or services, or artwork of any kind without prior written permission.

Out of concern and consideration for the Straz Center's patrons, artists, unions, students, volunteers and staff, circumstances will not always allow for photographer access. Therefore, photo rules and restrictions vary by event.
